Facebook can help us build relationships. It's like face-to-face conversations, phone calls, and letters. In some ways it's worse than those and in others, better — for example, we can send and reply quickly with text, photos, and video.

It's easy to use — just type your message where it says "What's on your mind" and click "Post". Click "Comment" to reply to a friend's message.

We can share information and discuss issues we'd rather keep among ourselves. Information posted in the Group appears in the News Feeds only of the Group's members, and our replies are seen only by members.
